

Winter Session Course BUDGET for Chile

Expenses will vary depending on personal spending and the currency exchange rate for many course sites. For planning purposes, the tentative budget includes:

Course Deposit	\$300
Will be used to book ground transportation to various field sites, one collective dinner a week, a few small gifts for Chilean organizers.	
Hotel, local transportation, meals	\$1,150
Hotel reservations will be arranged by David Rockefeller Center for two or three per room (@\$25-30 per day, meals in room and inexpensive restaurants \$20-40 per day, \$5-10 per day for metro and taxis for 3 weeks. Figure is average.	
No Visa for US citizens	
Various requirements for other citizens, check with Chilean Consulate	
Airfare (estimate)	\$1,300
Students receive 25% of the economy round-trip airfare (as funded by the Office for Students) up to a set limit, based upon the airfare between Boston and the location of travel, regardless of where the student originates the trip.	
Vaccinations not required
