Program Fees Paid Directly to Harvard	
Study Abroad Program fee, including one-week orientation and language program, special Harvard activities, seminars, internal trips and one organized trip to Buenos Aires for 3 days , term-time internship, enrollment for credit in Chilean Universities. Family Stay: room, board (3 meals a day), laundry. Overhead administrative costs.	\$18,750
Payment in full of \$18,750 is required by July 1st for fall semester and by February 1st for spring semester.

Total paid to Harvard University directly on term bill	\$21,768
PERSONAL OUT OF POCKET EXPENSES (ESTIMATES)	
Estimated personal expenses including, books, materials, transportation, some travel	\$3,200
Estimated round-trip travel from U.S. to Chile (student makes own reservations)	\$1,400
Chilean National ID and one-time fee to enter Chile from the USA	\$170
Estimated study abroad including travel (one semester)	\$26,538
